

Referee's Announcements for Faults

1. **Balk** – In case of a balk, the referee will tell the scoring table to deduct 2 points from each judge's score. The announcer shall read the judges scores with the 2 point deduction. If the diver balks a second time on the same dive, the referee shall call a fail dive.
2. **Falling off the Board** – If a diver falls off the board, the referee shall call a fail dive.
3. **Less Than Three Steps** – The judges shall deduct two points from each score.
4. **Complete Break** – When a dive has been done in a totally different position than was announced, the referee shall call a complete break and instruct the judges to give no more than a 2.
5. **Body Part Entry** – If the diver does not land in the water with the proper body part first, a fail dive will be called.
6. **Over or Under-Twisting** – If the diver twists more or less than 90 degrees (1/4 turn) of what was announced, the referee shall call a fail dive.
